GPFL is fully committed to implementing and maintaining its FSC® Certification for the long-term. This includes a commitment that forest management practices will adhere with FSC Principles and Criteria and all related normative documents.

As part of this commitment, GPFL commits to the transition to full Forest Management certification prior to the end of their certificate expiry.

In addition, GPFL will not associate with organizations that have been engaged in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal harvesting or illegal trade in forest products;
- b) Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector;
- c) Violation of workers' rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or forest products sector;
- d) Destruction of High Conservation Values (HCV) in forest or High Conservation Value areas;
- e) Conversion of natural forest cover;
- f) Use of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations for any other purposes than research.

GPFL are also committed to ensuring compliance with the *Illegal Logging Prohibition Act, 2012* and will support organisations requesting information to ensure compliance with the Act.
